Zizamele Ceramics was founded in 2008 by Toni Burton who taught ceramics skills at a local college. She taught the present members of Zizamele on an 18-month long job creation course in craft production. Once the group had qualified, it seemed inconceivable to send the participants back to a life of poverty in their local township, Masiphumulele.

Toni is the entrepreneur of the group and a few very tough years followed while she established the products in the marketplace. Two things were in place—a talented and loyal team and a great product. All the original artists are still part of Zizamele plus two new members who joined the group more recently.

The signature product is the UBUNTU BOWL, an African version of the Friendship Bowl. The female figures hold hands around the rim of a hand-thrown bowl, in a spirit of unity, wearing their traditional African headscarves

with their babies on their backs. Alongside, is a range of related products: candlesticks, vases, slip-cast animals, functional products and a range of hand-modelled items. Hand-painted in vibrant African patterns in glorious glazes, these unique once off pieces are all signed, stamped and dated for their collectability.

"Making World Class Ceramics in Africa"

Zizamele creates highly sought after and collectable ceramic pieces that can be found in all around the world and is increasingly exporting to international stores and galleries. Each artist has their own speciality and training is ongoing, as is product development. The staff have been offered shares in the business and are being assisted to embrace the new responsibilities and roles that this entails.

Plans for the future include an expanded product range that includes a new ceramic range, textiles and jewellery.

ORDERS:

- All prices in ZAR and shipped ex-works unless otherwise stated.
- Please follow our minium sales units per style and colour when placing wholesale orders. Min order is R4000.00
- Lead time for orders 6-8 weeks unless otherwise arranged.
- Please order in writing and specify any special instructions.

FREIGHT AND SHIPPING:

- We are happy to work with your specific service providers, or we can arrange shipping for you ourselves with our domestic courier – Kargo National.
- We do make use of EMS (expedited mail service) which is through the post office for smaller international orders.
 They will only insure for loss and not breakage. This is a tracked mail service. Should this item break en route replacement will be done free of charge but freight will be for the client's cost.
- National deliveries are only insured by ourselves if their value is greater than R10 000.
- We can quote on sending orders via airfreight or ocean

- freight for export, with our Freight Agent.
- All freight charges domestic and international are for the client's account.

PAYMENT TERMS AND INSTRUCTIONS:

- On placement of an order, an invoice will be supplied with all our details.
- Our terms are 50% deposit on placement of order, and balance on shipping.
- We will require balance of payment on presentation (via fax or email) of the freight documents or Bill of Lading for export, or on delivery as applicable.
- All goods remain property of our company until fully paid for.
- Please quote your invoice number as a reference when making payments.
