


Public grant for developing markets:

Business Partnership Support



Business Partnership Support aims to engage Finnish companies and other commercial actors in achieving the UN Sustainable Development Goals through creating sustainable and decent jobs. At the same time, this creates opportunities for growth and internationalisation for Finnish companies in developing markets.

Business Partnership Support enables you to:

- establish a new company or joint venture
- start importing or subcontracting
- sign a franchising or licensing agreement
- pilot with an international organisation

Apply for funding at the start

Describe and budget the project phases on your application based on your knowledge at that moment, aiming towards the desired long-term business activities. The final result often differs from the initial idea, and we understand this. The financial support is available for the project phases listed below, **from €15,000 to €400,000**.

Preparation phase

Feasibility study

Drafting a business plan

Assessing environmental and social impacts

Piloting technology and solutions, demonstrations

Implementation phase

Training of local staff

Development of existing business in the target country
