In 2016, we conducted a nationwide business plan competition in partnership with the USAID SEED Fund. The competition received 4700 applications from youth participants who submitted their ideas through 1000 proposals. This program aimed to identify and support promising entrepreneurs and promote innovation and economic growth in the country.

## Employment Promotion Project

A project aimed to enhance the capacity of technical and vocational education teachers to deliver entrepreneurship curriculum in public schools. EYouth is responsible for providing training to teachers, who will serve as potential facilitators, on entrepreneurship curricula and facilitation skills. This training will enable them to effectively implement the curricula. Additionally, EYouth will train placement facilitators on Career Guidance, which will be delivered in the Career Centers. Furthermore, EYouth has conducted additional training sessions for Master trainers and Multipliers. These trainers will continue the capacity building process for the facilitators, ensuring the sustainability of the project. In addition, the project intends to train 167 facilitators in entrepreneurship skills, 54 facilitators in employment skills, and 55 experienced trainers in the required skills. Moreover, 50 employees from the Ministry of Education will receive training in administrative skills to effectively manage the overall process.
