Strategic development directions (2025-2026):

1. Greenhouses – introduction of closed ground for vegetable production in the off-season
2. Own energy generation – installation of a diesel or gas generator, consideration of a cogeneration unit
3. Drilling a well – providing water for irrigation systems
4. Poultry farming – launching chicken coops with modern equipment
5. Oil extraction plant (OEP) – construction of a small processing complex for oilseeds
6. Renewable energy – installation of a solar power plant (SPP) and a wind turbine (WTP) to reduce dependence on external energy supply
7. Granary – construction of a modern warehouse with active ventilation and temperature control
8. Freezing line – deep-freezing chamber for fruits, berries, meat and vegetables
