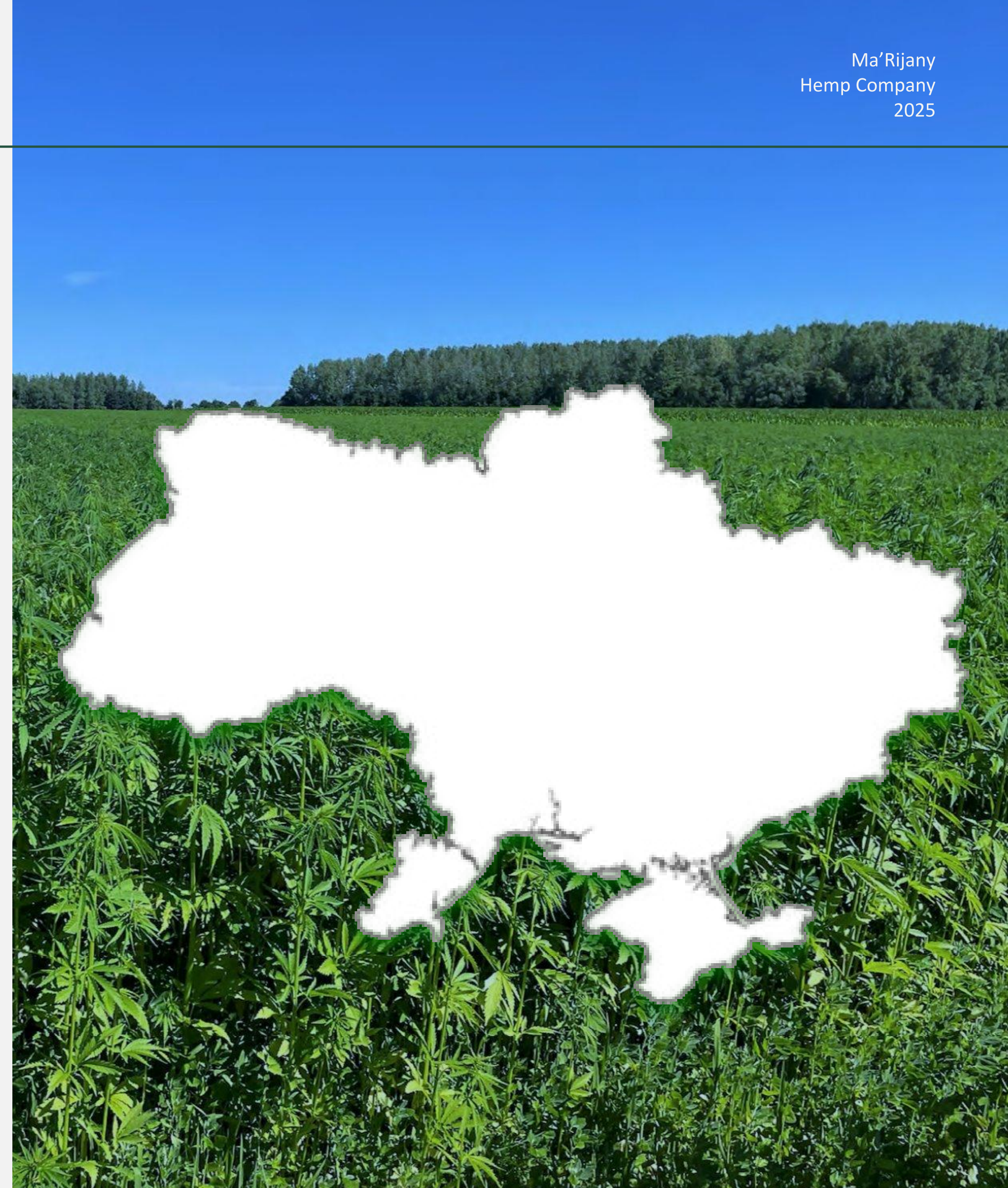

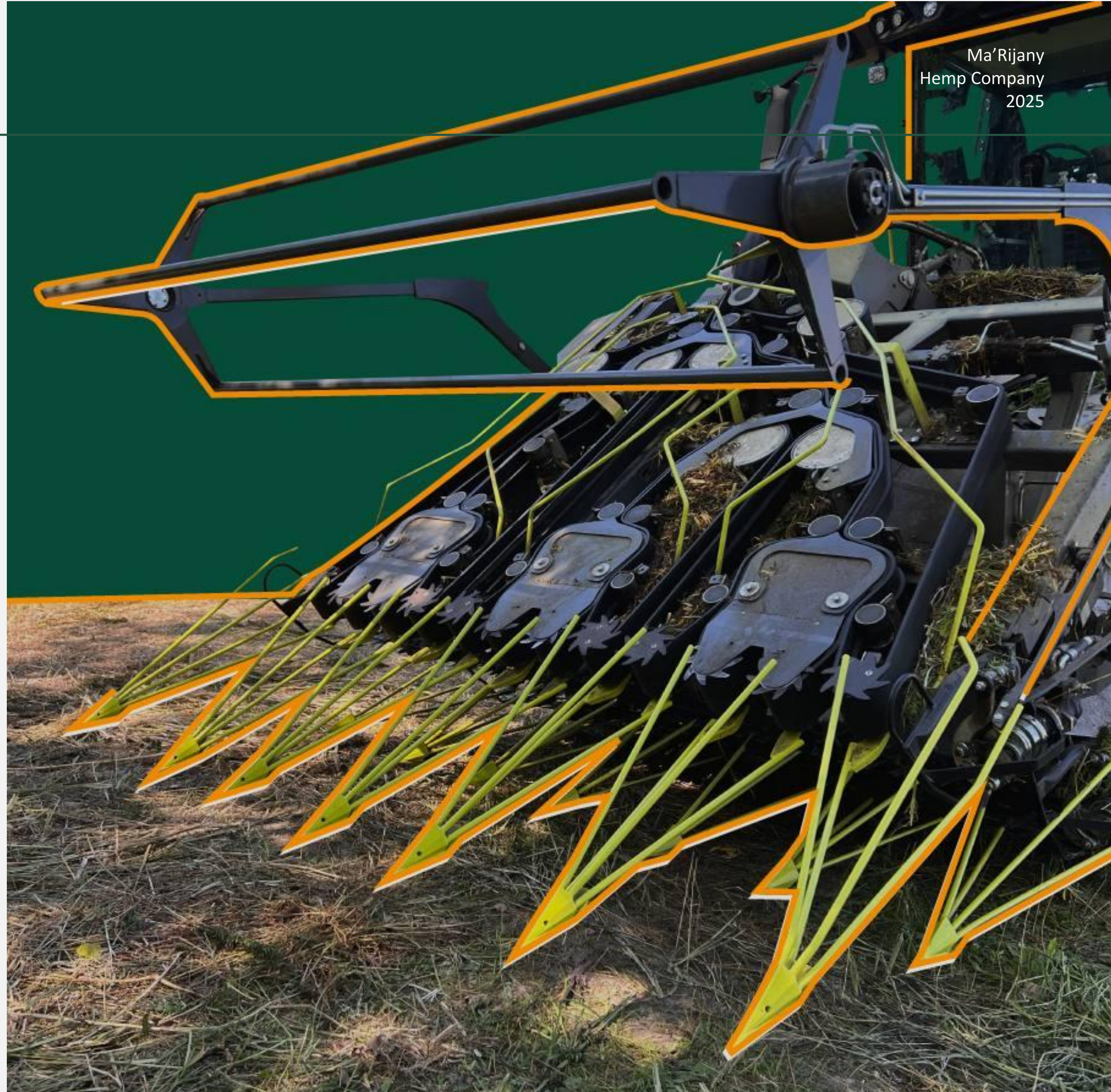

Our company is primarily interested in developing long-term relationships and integrating into the European textile industry ecosystem, which will enhance the resilience and competitiveness of EU manufacturers.

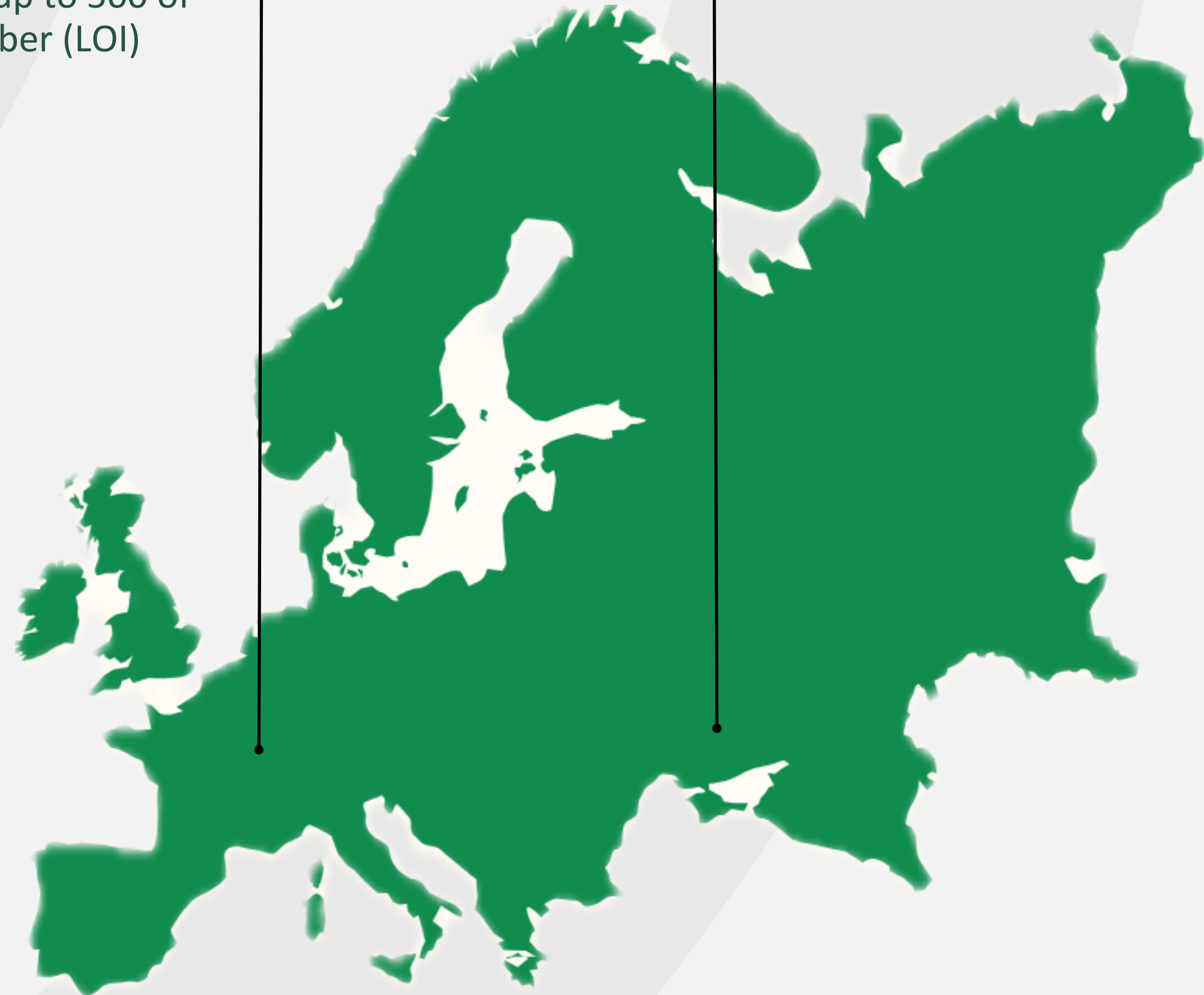

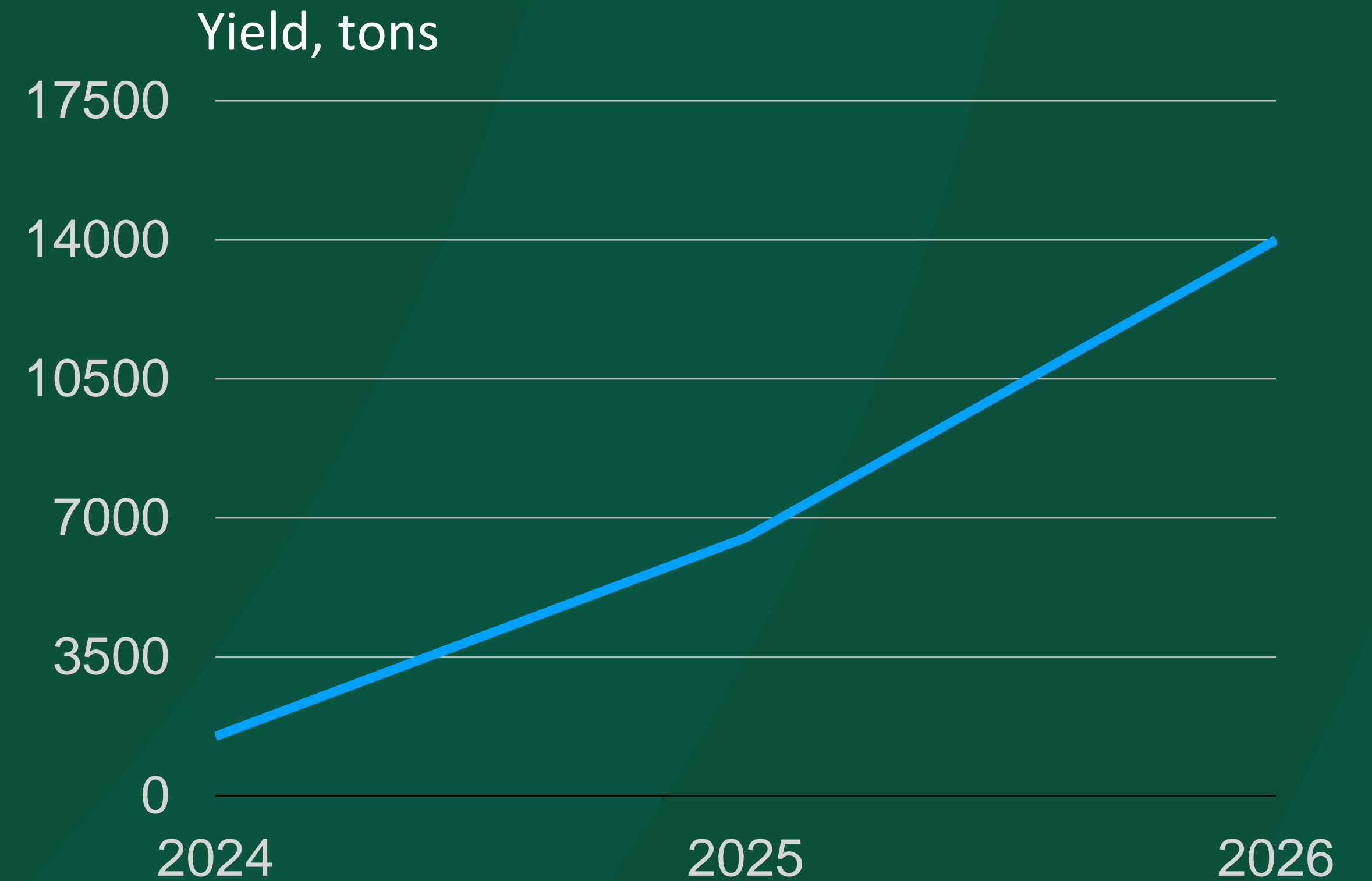
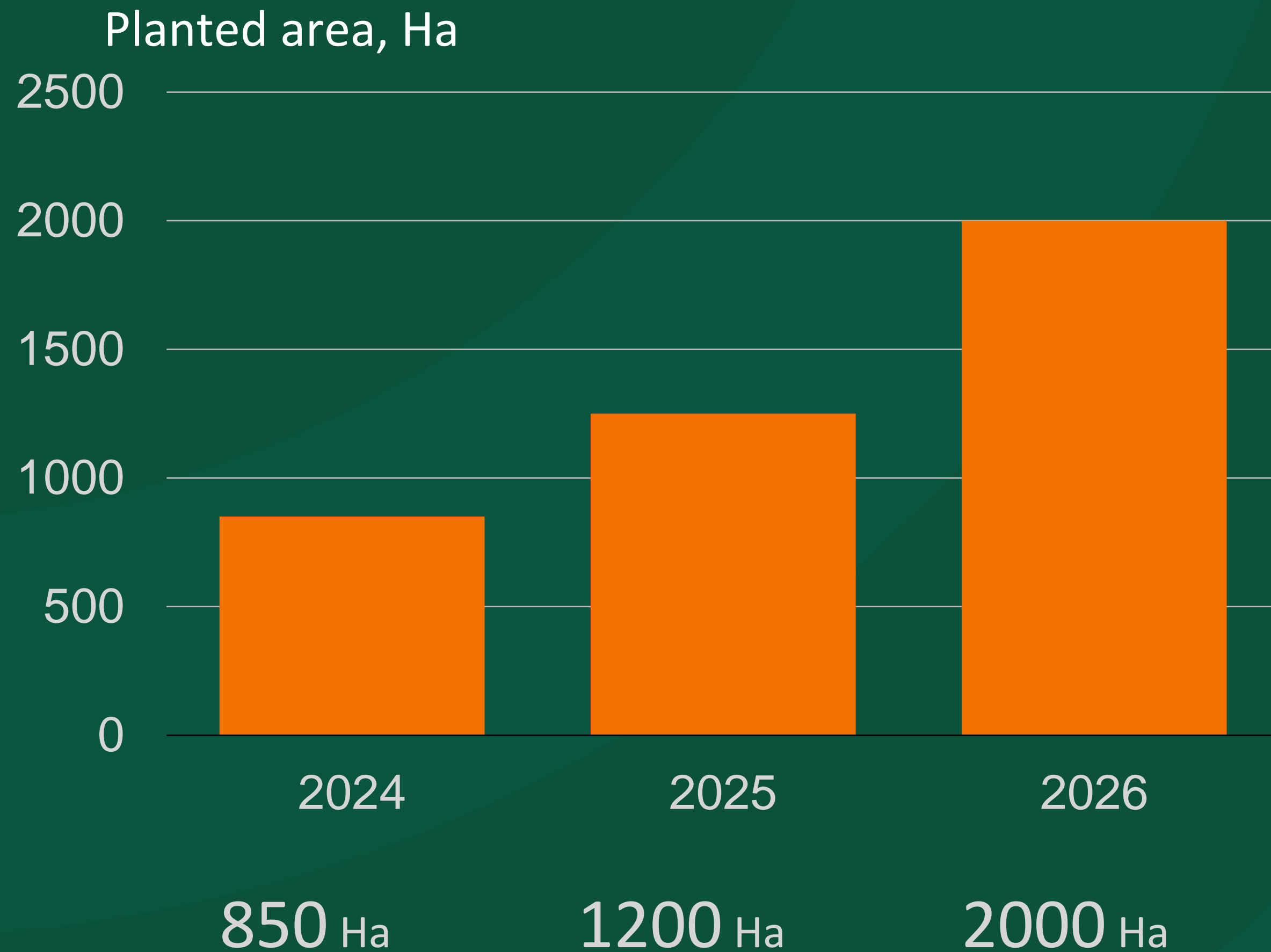
